

## Street sweeping 22

**Additional comments**

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## Case

- 1 One of our watersheds dumps into the impaired elk river watershed. Street sweeping would be a another factor in our BMP's to meet the phosphorus reductions
  
- 2 This is a great move by the PCA, and it will greatly help MS4s by potentially allowing credit for increased sweeping s. I hope the full PCA stormwater division is ready to help move this forward and that it isn't left to one PCA staff p erson to manage.
  
- 4 The soil left after screening has no compaction because of the organics left in it and being untested no one wants it for fill! ( what to do with it? )
  
- 35 I would like to see look into possibly an approach county wide for dealing with sweepings. Processing, storing, haul ing, etc.
  
- 61 As a consultant, I represent multiple communities with varying needs.
  
- 66 There is no mention of managing inorganic materials from sweepings such as sand/gravel and I am curious why it i s not.
  
- 78 Despite the challenges associated with processing street sweeping materials, the idea of producing a tool that poin ts to street sweeping as a water quality BMP that can be used to target water quality goals is highly desirable to M S4 communities. Communities would also benefit if research was expanded in the future to include other target poll utants outside of phosphorus.
