- 1. Place Stormwater Marker on curb of storm drain you have adopted. This marker indicates where the stormwater goes.
- 2. Clean the stormwater drain of twigs, leaves, grass clippings, and debris after each rainfall.
- 3. Collect and dispose the above items in the garbage.
- 4. Monitor the stormwater drain for one year beginning in August.
- 5. Learn about stormwater pollution.
