City Code 26-34 sub. 19 states throwing, placing, depositing, or burning leaves, trash, or lawn clippings, weeds, grass or other material in streets, alley, or gutters is punishable as a misdemeanor.

#### Clean Water Starts With Clean Streets

Homeowners with storm drains located by their homes are asked to help the Public Works Department to keep it clear of litter and leaves.

Blocked storm drains provide a greater chance of flooding.

Your neighbors and city will appreciate and thank you for your effort.

NOTE: In urban areas, stormwater carries phosphorus and other pollutants directly into Minnesota's water resources through the storm water drainage system. Unlike other household waste waters, stormwater doesn't go through a treatment plant first, it is dumped directly into lakes, rivers and wetlands.
