


Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan Enforcement Response Procedures



Enforcement response procedures are designed to discover and confront stormwater pollution violations in a systematic way in order to correct those violations and protect the environment. Many stormwater pollution violations occur because citizens are simply unaware of pollution prevention regulations; so, an Environmental Good Housekeeping Reminder serves to inform them about the rules and then require code compliance. Other violations are deemed more serious because they pose significant threats to stormwater due to the size and scope of those violations. Contractors, builders, and developers who disturb more than one acre of land, are highly regulated and require constant inspections for best management practices and required documentation.

According to the Red Wing City Code, stormwater pollution is a misdemeanor offence and it will be prosecuted if a pollution violation cannot or will not be corrected or resolved within a required period of time.
